## From the All Souls Health Ministry: FLU VACCINE

*We will be giving flu shots on October 23th  
from 8:00 a.m. 'til 11:00 a.m.*

Because there is a limited amount of vaccine to give, we are asking individuals who have access to a flu shot from their health care provider to obtain one from them.

*Criteria this year for the flu vaccine are those people at high risk for complications from influenza:*

- People **65 years of age and older.**
- People 18 years and older who have **long-term health problems** with:
  - Heart disease                      -Kidney disease
  - Lung disease                        -Metabolic disease,
  - Asthma                                    such as diabetes
  - Anemia, and other  
    blood disorders

**\*\*Hypertension is not considered a high risk condition\*\***

- People 18 years and older with certain conditions (such as **neuromuscular disorders**) that can cause breathing problems.
- People 18 years and older with a **weekend immune system.**



**Scrip Program**

Scrip are certificates issued by participating merchants and are used just like cash to buy merchandise. A portion of the amount you spend on Scrip comes back to the school, usually between 4% to 13%. However, you get dollar for dollar on what you pay for Scrip.

It has been an excellent fundraiser for the school for many years now. We have scrip for Home Depot, several restaurants, department stores, Shell & Chevron Gas. If we do not have an item in stock, we can special order practically anything.

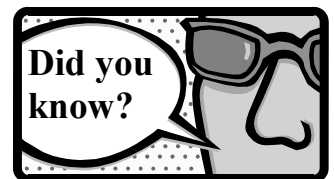
## **Ralphs** Community Partner Cards

## COME TO THE FEAST

“On this mountain, the Lord of hosts / will provide for all peoples / a feast of rich food and choice wines” (Isaiah 25:6). That’s what Isaiah tells us today. God is putting together a huge party for “all peoples,” to “wipe away / the tears from every face” (Isaiah 25:8).

And what does Jesus tell us? The reign of God, he says, “may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son” (Matthew 22:2). When the guests didn’t come, the king had his servants, go out “into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find” (Matthew 22:9). We are called to deliver that invitation.

One of the themes woven into today’s liturgy is that of divine generosity. Asleep to reality, people often think they have “earned” what they have. In our better moments, though, we know that all our gifts—even the spiritual gifts—come through God’s generosity. Our vocation is to invite people, to remind them the tickets aren’t for sale. We can only show up and say thank you.
